## Talk, Read, Play Intensive

Are you looking to engage your staff and families in a Talk Read Play project? - To Enroll your site in The Family Conservancy's Talk, Read, Play Intensive Model. As a program participant, your staff members will receive multiple training sessions about the importance of talking, reading, and playing in an early childhood setting. They will also learn how to effectively engage parents with the important message that adult interactions matter at home, too. In addition to trainings, staff are provided with multiple personalized coaching sessions to support the implementation of course content on site.

Participating sites will host parent engagement events at which parents are given the opportunity to sign up for weekly text message reminders to talk, read, and play with their kids every day. The Family Conservancy can further support program sites with a donation of books to build a lending library, and funds to supplement the cost of putting on parent engagement events.
