Families enrolled in one of the Start Young Child Care Providers in Wyandotte County are eligible for a number of different supplemental scholarship opportunities to assist paying for child care for children ages 0-5. Please use the information below to determine eligibility based on family income levels. If a family's income is at a certain level or lower (based on their family size including all adults and children in the household), they may be eligible for the program indicated in the far right column. Please note that some other factors of eligibility may apply (refer to gap funding descriptions).
